Tournament Format

Saturday morning will be pool play with all matches being two out of three. Games one and two will be rally score to 25 points. Game three, if needed, will be rally score to 15 points (and there will be no cap on any games). After the conclusion of pool play, 1st and 2nd place teams will advance to the Gold Division and 3rd & 4th place teams will advance to the Silver Division. Playoff matches will begin Saturday afternoon and will be one rally score game to 25 points. There will be paid SDFVOA officials assigned as the up refs and then your team will need to provide players to do book, lines, and keep score during your team’s assigned reffing duties.

Awards

Team awards will be given out to the 1st and 2nd place teams in the Gold Division and 1st place and 2nd place teams in the Silver Division. All-Tournament awards will be given to 7 players (6 plus 1 MVP) in each of the Divisions. Coaches and tournament directors will vote on these awards.
